

CAL-BRED DEFINITIONS & RULES



CALIFORNIA-BRED PROGRAM FOR RACING ARABIANS

California state law to promote horse racing, as well as agricultural business, within the state, provides the Cal-Bred Incentive Premium Awards program. The purpose of the program is to add an incentive to breed and race Arabian horses in California. Each time a registered Cal-Bred runs first or second in a race within the state, the horse earns cash awards for its owner, its breeder and its sire's owners. The Arabian Racing Association of California (ARAC) is the official administrator of the Cal-Bred Awards program. The cash awards are generated by the money wagered on the Arabian races run in the state and are distributed on a yearly basis.

- **WHO IS CAL-BRED ELIGIBLE?**

A purebred Arabian horse registered with the Arabian Horse Association foaled in California after being conceived in California by a stallion standing in California; or a purebred Arabian foal conceived outside of California, in 1986 or after, but is dropped by the mare in California if the said mare remains in California to be bred next to an Arabian stallion standing in California. **The foal resulting from this rebreeding must be dropped in the State of California to be Cal-Bred eligible.** If said mare cannot be bred for two (2) successive years, but remains in California during that period of time, her foal shall remain Cal-Bred eligible.

- **BREEDER'S AWARDS:**

The person/persons listed, as "breeder" of record by the Arabian Horse Association shall receive a sum based upon the prorated share of first and second place earnings from 55% of the award's fund.

- **OWNER'S AWARDS:**

The CHRB licensed persons (owner or lessee) listed in the official racing program at the time of the race shall receive a sum based upon the prorated share of first and second place earnings from 20% of the award's fund.

- **SIRE AWARDS:**

The stallion owner on December 31st of each racing year, as recorded with the Arabian Horse Association, shall receive a sum based upon the prorated share from 15% of the award's fund for all get which placed first or second in one or more races run in California. For a stallion to qualify as a Cal-Bred sire, the stallion must have stood in California during the year his Cal-Bred progeny raced and remain in the state the entire calendar year.

- **AWARD FUND:**

Ten percent of the award fund shall be used to promote the Cal-Bred program and Arabian racing in California. Any amount not used shall be returned to the fund.

- **REGISTRATION FEES:** Registration completed

On or before December 31 of the foaling year\$25.00(Member) \$50.00(Non-member)

On or before December 31 of their two year old year. \$50.00(Member) \$75.00(Non-member)

On or after January 1 of their three year old year\$75.00(Member)\$100.00(Non-member)

- **NOTICE:**

For a horse to be considered Cal-Bred the registration process must be completed 48 hours before time of entry. The applicant is responsible to notify the Administrator of any changes in application information. The Cal-Bred program may be changed at any time by legislation or the ARAC Board of Directors.
