## **Cal-Bred Sire Rules and Procedures**

**For a stallion to be eligible for Sire Awards**, the stallion must have been standing in California for the year when conception of foal occurred and during the calendar year when the qualifying races occurred.

Stallion awards shall **not** be made to the owner of a sire that has been out of the state for breeding purposes during the calendar year. [CA Business and Professions Code, Div. 8, Chapter 4. Horse Racing [19617.8 (a) (E)]

If a sire dies in California and stood his entire last season at stud in this state, he shall thereafter continue to be considered an eligible Cal-Bred Arabian sire, if recertified and claims are made for the years his Cal-Bred foals are racing. His owner would be eligible for awards earned by Cal-Bred Registered foals conceived before his death, but not be eligible for foals conceived by whatever means after his death.

The Stallion owner, as recorded with the Arabian Horse Association as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the racing year, shall, after February 15 of the following year, and if an official claim for awards has been submitted, be awarded a sum based on the prorated share of the Sire Awards Fund for all get which placed first and second in one or more races run in California.

## Claims for Cal-Bred Sire Awards and Re-Certification:

"On or before Feb. 15<sup>th</sup> of any year, the stallion owner shall advise the official registering agency of any and all purses earned during the preceding year to be considered in determining the amount of the stallion award to which the owner is entitled. Stallion claim forms are due February 15, whether or not the official registering agency solicits them."

[CA B. & P. Code, Div. 8, Chapter 4. Article 9.5, 19617.8, (2)(F)(3)]

**NOTE:** Though ARAC, as a courtesy, may send reminders re submitting Sire claims forms, it is not required to do so. Mail (electronic or other) is sometimes lost or not noticed. It is recommended that Sire owners keep a record during the racing year of the sire's Cal-Bred foals' accomplishments in California races, to aid in completing the Claims report at the end of the year. **See C-B Sire Claims & Re-Certification Form.** 

**NOTE:** The applicant is to notify the Administrator of any changes in the application information.

**NOTE:** The Cal-Bred program may be changed at any time by State Legislation, or by the ARAC Board of Directors.
